PRESBYTERY OF CINCINNATI MEETING HERE We are hosting the May 11, 2010 meeting of the Presbytery of Cincinnati. The meeting will be called to order at about 5:00pm, but people will be arriving as early as an hour before that. We are expecting somewhere between 150–200 guests. We need some volunteers to help us accomplish that.

For example, we need 2 greeters who can do that (greet!) and show folks where they need to go to register, for light snacks, and to restrooms. They need to be here from 4–6pm.

We need 4 people who can collate papers and after doing that, register commissioners from 3–6pm.

We need 2–4 people in the parking lot to direct traffic. They need to be here from 4–5:30pm.

We need 6 volunteers to prepare and serve a light snack and finger foods from 3-6:30pm.

The Presbytery can help defray food costs, but I'm hoping that many of you will bake something to feed our guests.

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LETTER CARRIERS "STAMP OUT HUNGER" FOOD DRIVE MAY 8 One of the biggest food drives of the year is coming up in Northern Kentucky and you don't even have to leave home to participate.
